- a. What aspects of David's life would lead God to say that David was a man after his own heart (1 Sam 13:14 et al)?
- b. Doesthis passage about David's sin negate this description of David? Why?
- 3. Does our response to sin indicate anything about our heart?
- a. What did David's response say about his heart?
- b. What does the church's response to sin say about the church?

- a. Why did God use Nathan?
- b. Does God use people to correct behaviour in the Church today?
- c. If so, what works and what doesn't?!
