Sermon: A New Growth in the Wasteland

Scripture: Isaiah 43:18-19

Questions:

1. Isaiah prefaces the message of the Lord to the exiles by reminding the people of the Exodus from Egypt in Isaiah 43:16-17. Why was the Exodus a significant event to the Israelites?
2. After reminding the people of the Exodus from Egypt, Isaiah 43:18 says "Forget the former things, do not dwell on the past." What does it mean to remember the past, but not dwell on it?
3. The wilderness is often a place of trial or temptation in the Bible. What are some ways you have experienced "the wilderness" in your own life? How did you or are you seeing God moving during those times?
4. Where are you seeing signs of God's renewal in your life, in your city, and in the world? Where is it challenging to see renewal?
5. Have you seen God move in a way you didn't expect? How were you surprised by God?
